

UVA in Shanghai: Internship, Culture, and Language

Summer 2020

Internship Courses:

CHIN3559 Independent study-Chinese for professional world: 1 credit 8 hours in the first week and 1 hour/week from Week 2 to Week 8.

GSGS 3220 Making Culture Visible While Studying Abroad. (1 credit) 2 hours/week. This course will be offered by the native Chinese UVA graduate student as the program coordinator

Each student will earn 2 credits in total in this program.

Internship Proposed itinerary:

May 20 (W): Internship program students leave for Shanghai

May 21 (Th): Internship students arrive at ECNU

May 22 (Fri): Internship students' orientation with the Program Coordinator (Group meal #1).

Go to the local Bureau to change internship students' visa. If visa cannot be changed today, it has to be done in the following week.

May 23 (Sat): Program Coordinator leads the students to explore Shanghai (Group meal #2)

May 25 (M)-28 (Th): Liang teaches two hours Chinese instruction in the mornings. Cultural and practicum with the Program Coordinator two hours afterwards

May 29 (Fri): Student visit their intern offices and get familiarized with their routes

May 30 (Sat): Welcome banquet with the language program teachers and students. Group activities.

June 1 (M): Students start to work in their office. One hour tutorial session per week starts from this week.

June 6 (Sat): One day trip to SWFC, and the Bunds with the Program Coordinator

July 4 (Sat): July 4th Celebration with the Program Coordinator

July 24 (Fri): Farewell banquet with the Chinese language program students and teachers

July 25 (Sat): The program ends and the students and the Program Coordinator leave ECNU
