Pre-internship preparation requirements:

- Students will need to work closely with ITT and the UVA Global Internships program to gather necessary documentation to apply for the appropriate German visa/work permit as soon as he/she commits to the position (offers will be sent around January 15th). The process is lengthy (~3 months).
 - Because the visa application process is so lengthy, selected students will *only have four business days* to commit to an internship offer. Please be ready to provide your
 decision, if selected.

- If under their care, students must have their parents/guardian's permission to apply for this position before submitting an application.
