How many teaching weeks are there in a semester?	18 weeks per semester (16 teaching weeks + 2 exam weeks)
How is a credit point defined?	One instruction hour (45 minutes) per week throughout the semester stands for one credit at Fudan. An academic semester includes 18 weeks.

Can students extend their exchange stint?	Yes. Application deadlines: May 15 (for Fall Semester) or Nov. 15 (for Spring Semester)

Courses that are only available in one particular semester	Spring and Fall course schedules are different.
What is normal exchange student load per semester?	6-15 credits for one semester (2-8 courses) (10 credits per semester on average)
Are students allowed to take cross-faculty courses? If yes, are there any restrictions?	Yes. So long as the courses can be applied online successfully.
